

What is Phonics Screening?

The Phonics Screening is a compulsory assessment that all children in year 1 must take. It is used to assess your child's phonic decoding skills. There are 40 words in the check which is split into sections progressing from simple words to trickier words with five or six letters. Half of the words that children are expected to read are 'nonsense words' that have no meaning. The screening will take place in the second week of June and will be carried out by your child's class teacher.

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
