What should I already know?

Religious Education

- religion refers to people's faith
- describes different ways of worship
- enquires about how beliefs shape lives and behaviours.

SACRE objectives

- Discuss the different ways that people pray and find out how and why people pray in different religions
- Pupils look at how different people have expressed their ideas about God, and think and talk about their own ideas about God

Powerful knowledge

Muslims pray 5 times a day. They kneel down, then lay down and then stand up. They face Mecca when they pray. They have to wash their arms and feet before they pray.



Praying 5 times a day helps Muslims talk to God (Allah), be good and feel calm. Like in all religions, praying makes people feel closer to their God.
