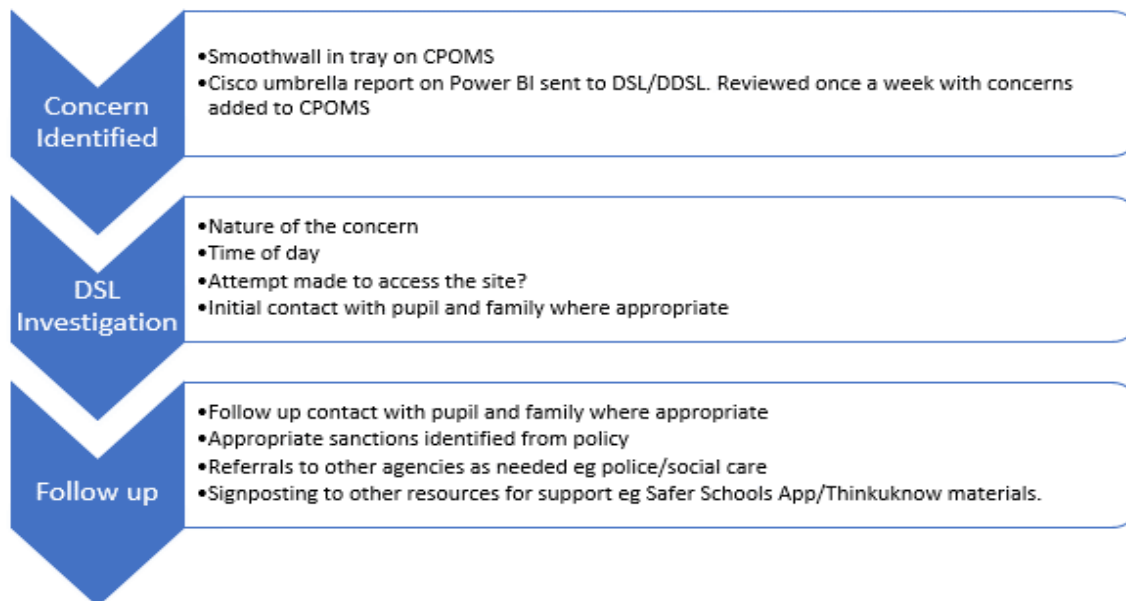

Tier	Sanction	Follow – up
	Removal of access to device for up to one week	<p>Discussion with child and parents/carers. All incidents will be fully investigated, including gaining an understanding of the context, before sanctions are applied. Any concerns will be referred to outside agencies as required.</p> <p>Incident recorded on CPOMS with evidence from Smoothwall/Cisco umbrella attached (if applicable).</p> <p>Repetition of this behaviour will result in an additional sanction double the length of the first.</p> <p>A third instance of this behaviour will result in permanent removal of the device. During periods of lockdown, a paper pack will be issued if a device is removed in order to provide continuity of education.</p>
	Removal of access to device for up to 3 days	<p>Discussion with child and parents/carers. All incidents will be fully investigated, including gaining an understanding of the context, before sanctions are applied. Any concerns will be referred to outside agencies as required.</p> <p>Incident recorded on CPOMS with evidence from Smoothwall attached (if applicable).</p> <p>Repetition of this behaviour will be considered 'red' behaviour.</p>
