

Make Your Own Compass Rose

Follow the step-by-step instructions to create your own compass rose.

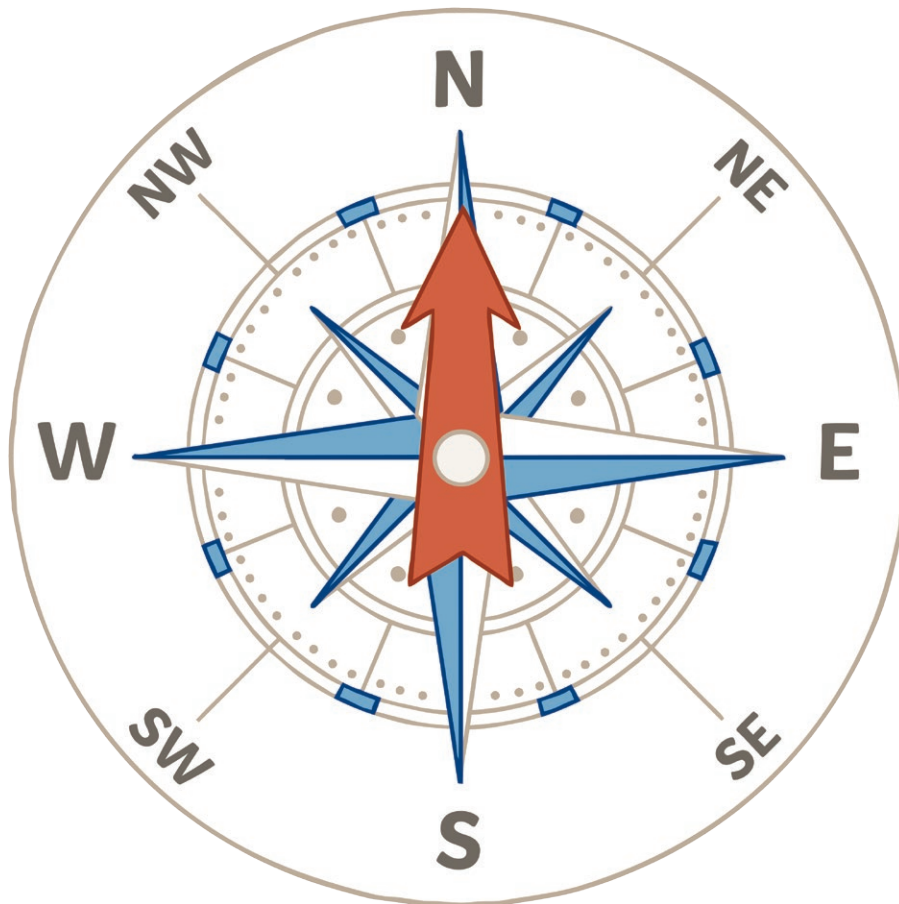
Instructions

1. Carefully cut out the 4 shapes below – 1 circle, 1 large arrow cross, 1 small arrow cross and 1 red direction arrow.
2. Line the small cross up with the arrows pointing diagonally like an “X” and glue in the centre of the circle.
3. Line up the centre of the large cross with the centre of the small cross, with the arrows pointing up and down like a “+” and glue in place.
4. Starting with “North” at the top, write the labels on the example below, next to the compass points.
5. Stick a small piece of sticky tack in the centre of the crosses and attach the red direction arrow to it.

You will need:

- A pair of scissors
- Glue
- A pen
- A small piece of sticky tack

Your finished compass rose should look like this:
