

It has been a great start to the half term. Thank you for your continued support.


I have really enjoyed seeing all the amazing learning the children have been doing.

Flu Immunisations are coming to school on Tuesday

30th November. The children's nasal spray flu vaccine is safe and effective. It's offered every year to children to help protect them against flu.

The nasal spray flu vaccine is free on the NHS for all primary school children (reception to year 6).

The vaccine is given as a spray squirted up each nostril. It's quick and painless. The nasal spray flu vaccine gives children the best protection against flu. It may take around 2 weeks for the flu vaccine to work.

Any children who catch flu after vaccination are less likely to be seriously ill or be admitted to hospital.

If you have already signed the consent form, there is nothing else for you to do. There is still time to sign a consent form. Come to the main office to complete one.

On Friday 10th December we will have a special Christmas themed menu. Children will also receive a festive cracker.





You should get a coronavirus test if you have any of these symptoms.





What to do if you have a positive Covid-19 test result

1. If you have any of these symptoms, you need to get a Coronavirus test
2. Book a test by calling 111 or go online at <https://self-referral.test-for-coronavirus.service.gov.uk/antigen/condition> and book a drive through test, a walk through test or a home testing kit.
3. If you get a positive test result you must isolate for 10 days. However, members of your household only need to isolate if they are over the age of 18 and are not double vaccinated.
